Credit

Upon successful completion of a written examination (receiving a grade of 80% or above) participants are awarded certificates of completion. Participants will then be eligible to take Level II toward their National Certification.

Academy Information

The National Animal Control Association Training Academy was designed to be delivered in two levels. Upon successful completion of both Level I and Level II, the National Animal Control Association shall nationally certify each participant and issue the appropriate documentation and pin. Successful completion of Level I and Level II shall include a minimum passing score of 80% on written examinations and mandatory attendance during all training.

Location and Lodging

The school will be conducted in Nashville, Tennessee, at the **Holiday Inn Opryland/Airport, located at 2200 Elm Hill Pike in Nashville**. A special lodging rate of **\$89.00 per night, plus tax, single or double occupancy** has been arranged.
