## National Animal Control Association

It is **not** necessary to attend Level I before Level II.

## Tuition/Registration/Payment

## Credit

Upon successful completion of a written examination (receiving a grade of 80% or above) participants are awarded certificates of completion. Participants who have successfully completed Level I and Level II, will upon completion, be eligible to receive their National Certification.

## Academy Information

The National Animal Control Association Training Academy was designed to be delivered in two levels. Upon successful completion of both Level I and Level II, the National Animal Control Association shall nationally certify each participant and issue the appropriate documentation and pin. Successful completion of Level I and Level II shall include a minimum passing score of 80% on written examinations and mandatory attendance during all training.

## Location and Lodging

The school will be conducted in **Glenview, Illinois**, at the **Northeastern Illinois Public Safety Training Academy**, located at 2300 Patriot Boulevard in **Glenview**.
